

Michigan College Application Week

November 4-8, 2013

Approximately 90 percent of middle grade students say they plan to go to college, yet only about two-thirds of students do. For many reasons, by senior year many students believe they are unprepared or unable to achieve the college dream.

Michigan College Application Week encourages students to take a significant step toward college by providing assistance and creating enthusiasm during the application process.

The goal of MI College Application Week is to ensure every graduating high school senior completes at least one application. A special focus is placed on students who would be the first in their families to attend, low-income students, or students who may not have otherwise considered applying.

Thinking of hosting CAW at your school?

- Host sites are required to set aside time and space **during the school day** with computer and internet access. Paper applications can be acquired with advance notice.
- Host sites are expected to recruit enough volunteers to assist with students during the designated application times.
- Host sites will be required to track specific aggregate data established by the MI College Application Week committee.
- Michigan College Access Network will provide training and a resource manual to assist with the planning organization of your College Application Week activities.
- Host sites will set a goal of 100 percent of all graduating seniors to filling out AT LEAST one application to a postsecondary institution by the conclusion of College Application Week.
- **Application deadline is Friday, May 10!**
